

NORWAY TOWNSHIP BOARD MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES: April 13, 2026

Board members present: Don Byczek, Supervisor; Joyce Giuliani, Clerk; Jeff Edwards, Treasurer; Dave Solda, Trustee; Brian Pellegrini, Trustee.

1. Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. Pledge was recited.
2. Approve/amend agenda: motion to approve the agenda as presented was made by Edwards, seconded by Pellegrini. All ayes. Passed 5-0.
3. Citizens' Time: Chris Hansen – interested in land in Industrial Park
4. Approve minutes for last month's meeting: Motion was made by Solda, second by Pellegrini, to approve the minutes from the March 10th meeting as presented. All ayes. Passed 5-0.
5. Assessor's Time: Board of Review went well. Planning on visiting parcels in the east/central area of the township this year. There have been no building permits issued this year so far./
6. Financial reports: reports were reviewed and discussed.
7. Bills for approval: bills were reviewed. Motion was made by Pellegrini, second by Edwards, to approve the bills as presented. All ayes. Passed 5-0.

9. OLD BUSINESS:
 - a) Gravel pit: the conditional use permit was approved for gravel extraction only. Crushing of gravel and an asphalt plant are not allowed.
 - b) Cellphone tower: a conditional use permit application has been submitted for construction of a cellphone tower on Boundary Line Rd. A public hearing will be scheduled for May 4, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. with the Planning Commission meeting at 5:30 that night after the hearing.
10. NEW BUSINESS:
 - a) Norway-Vulcan Senior Center: resolution 2026-5 was passed (5-0) allowing the senior center to put a millage renewal request on the ballot in August.
 - b) Spring Rubbish Collection: the rubbish collection will be from Tuesday, May 19 – Thursday, May 21. Hours are from 10 am to 6 pm.
 - c) Carney Lake Board milfoil treatment: a letter was received from the Carney Lake Board request \$1,000 for milfoil treatment again this year. Motion was made by Pellegrini, second by Edwards, to send \$1,000 for milfoil treatment as we have in the past. All ayes. Passed 5-0.

(d) Router replacement: our router is outdated and in need of replacement. A quote was received from GoTech for a new router and installation of it. Motion was made by Solda, second by Giuliani, to order the new router. Passed 5-0.

(e) Road maintenance projects for 2026: board reviewed maintenance items that need to be done in the township this year. A list will be finalized at the May meeting and sent to the road commission.
