• Unfinished Business

- a) Roads: reviewed Neighborhood Road Funds information. Brickyard Road and corner by the church has been chip-sealed. Cherry St. was dug up for water/sewer line work. It should be repaired by the city of Norway since they did the work.
- b) Blight update: Carlson place is cleaned up and Carlson has moved out. Old school has been sold and is being cleaned out by owner. Vickers place is cleaned up.
- c) Replace township truck: after discussion, board members agreed to look into purchasing a new truck. Pellegrini, Chartier, and Byczek will present information at the next meeting.
- d) Update fee schedule for permits: draft copy was reviewed. Changes were suggested. Final draft will be voted on at the next meeting.

New Business

- a) Request for file sharing of township parcel data: A request was received from Tyler Chartier, who is working with a local real estate firm, to obtain a copy of the shapefile for the township assessing database. Motion was made by Pellegrini, supported by Giuliani, to grant access to the shapefile for a fee of \$750.00. All ayes. Passed 5-0. Giuliani will contact Chartier.
- b) MTA Training in Escanaba: there will be training sessions offered by MTA at the Island Resort on September 29, & 30. Contact Giuliani if you wish to go.
- c) Ad in platbook: a new platbook will be published for Dickinson County. They are looking for organizations to run ads. Board members declined.
- d) Status of parcels on Ski-View Drive: there are several very small parcels of land that are up for auction at the end of the cul-de-sacs on Ski View Drive. There is nothing that the township can do to prevent these parcels from being auctioned off.
